## **CLARENDON HILLS HOSTS FINAL CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT PUBLIC WORKSHOP**

The Village of Clarendon Hills is sponsoring its third and final public workshop regarding the central business district (CBD) planning process. The goal of this planning process is to develop a guide for future development and redevelopment in the downtown area. This final workshop will be held on Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will take place in the Prospect School Gymnasium at 100 N. Prospect Avenue in Clarendon Hills. All interested residents and business owners and operators are encouraged to attend.

The CBD planning process has taken place over the course of the last year. During this time, the Village has been working closely with a team of consultants to study ways to further enhance and revitalize the downtown and has held two public workshops to gauge resident insight. The first of these meetings was a community listening session where members of the residential and business community provided input pertaining to the future vision and redevelopment potential of the downtown. The input from that meeting was used as the basis for the community visioning workshop that was held in July. At this public

meeting, several redevelopment concepts were presented for participant feedback.

At the upcoming workshop, plans will be presented that reflect the overall vision for the future of the Central Business District. The Village's consultant team and staff will be present to facilitate the discussion amongst all attendees. Please plan to attend this important meeting!
