CLARENDON HILLS HOSTS CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT LISTENING SESSION
(Revised)

The Village of Clarendon Hills is sponsoring a *Listening Session* to gather input from the community about the future of the central business district (CBD). The Village is hoping to construct a vision for the downtown area that captures citizen insight. The goal of the CBD planning process is to develop a guide for future development and redevelopment in the downtown area. All interested residents and business owners and operators are encouraged to attend.

The *Listening Session* will be held on March 9, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be located in the Prospect School gymnasium at 100 N. Prospect Avenue in Clarendon Hills. Planning consultants will be present to help facilitate the discussion amongst all attendees.

The *Listening Session* will be the first of three meetings that will engage the community in formulating a plan for the downtown's future. The purpose of the following meetings will be to consolidate alternatives into a finalized CBD plan. More information concerning these meetings will be available in the near future.
