Police Chief Announces Retirement from Clarendon Hills

Pat Anderson, Police Chief for the Village of Clarendon Hills has retired from the Clarendon Hills Police Department. Anderson has served as Clarendon Hills Police Chief since 2003.

Anderson is credited for contributing to several milestones for the Clarendon Hills Police Department during his tenure, including the establishment of the Department's 'Alive at 25' driving safety program, the design and construction of a new police headquarters, and being the first police agency in Illinois to adopt the Lexipol police policy manual program. Anderson also was instrumental in the establishment of the Village's fiber optic network in partnership with the BNSF railway.

Clarendon Hills Village President Tom Karaba stated, "The Village of Clarendon Hills is a much improved community and better place to live because of Chief Anderson's passion for public service and dedication to this community. He will certainly be missed by his fellow Village employees, his colleagues in law enforcement in this region, and the community at large.
