## **2018 Water Main Improvements Update**

### **Week of 3/26 - Recap**

After receiving satisfactory chlorination results, crews completed installing the new water main on Arthur Avenue between Burlington Avenue and Chicago Avenue.

### **Week of 4/2 – Tentative Schedule**

We will continue to transfer water service lines, between 115 Arthur and 144 Arthur, to the new water main this week. We anticipate being done by Thursday, April 5<sup>th</sup>.

We are chlorination testing the new water main on Tuttle Avenue, between Burlington Avenue and Norfolk Avenue. We expect to receive the results of the test on Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>. Upon receiving a satisfactory result, we will resume installing the water main, starting at 121 Tuttle Avenue, going north to Chicago Avenue. We anticipate finishing this installation on Monday, April 9<sup>th</sup>.

Once the water main south of Norfolk has been tested and approved, we will transfer each water service line to this main on Monday, April 9<sup>th</sup>. We will begin at Burling Avenue and proceed north towards Norfolk. We anticipate transferring 8-10 service lines each day. The impacted residents on Tuttle Avenue will receive a notice on Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup> about the transfers. This work will require crews to shut off water to homes for approximately two hours while they make the transfer. Homeowners will be notified while it happens. We anticipate the transfers taking place April 9<sup>th</sup> through April 13<sup>th</sup>.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. Saturday work may be approved on a case by case basis by the Village depending on weather and progress. We will notify the bus company and the trash company of our active construction zones and we will coordinate with them to get your trash picked up on Tuesdays. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
