2018 Road Improvement Program

Weekend of 6/30

- Saturday, June 30th, the concrete subcontractor will finish concrete driveway aprons on the east side of Tuttle from Burlington to Chicago and the west side of Arthur between Burlington to Chicago. They will pouring new sidewalk at various locations along those streets.

Week of 7/2-

- Thursday, July 5th we will officially switch to the west side of Tuttle between Burlington and Chicago and the east side of Arthur between Burlington and Chicago.
- The process begins with closing the driveways closed beginning at 7:00am on Thursday, July 5th on those sides of these two streets.
- For those impacted, please park your cars on the side streets during the construction hours, 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM. You may park on the opposite side of the street overnight but please have cars removed by 7:00 AM. *Please remember, they are both southbound only streets.*
- Those displaced from their driveways are expected to be out of their driveways for a period of 10 – 14 days.
- On Friday, July 6th we expect to pour the new concrete shoulder on both streets and finish on the following Monday, July 9th. The concrete driveway aprons will be poured and will need 3-5 days cure time before re-opening the driveways on the two streets.
- Monday, July 2nd through Friday, July 6th they will be constructing new storm sewer and replacing culverts along Woodstock.
- On Monday, July 2nd and Tuesday, July 3rd, they will be working on Woodstock between Norfolk and Chicago. **There will be no construction on Wednesday, July 4th.**
- On Thursday July 5th they will resume working on the storm sewer work on Woodstock between Norfolk and Chicago.
- Throughout the week they will knock on doors to get cars removed if necessary and then once its backfilled you will have access back in your driveway.
- Notices will be posted today to alert impacted residents regarding their driveways being closed beginning on Thursday, July 5th on the west side of Tuttle and east side of Arthur.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Parking restrictions will be lifted during construction by the Police to allow residents to park near their homes overnight. We will notify the trash company of our active construction zones and we will coordinate with them to get your trash picked up on Tuesdays. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
