- **Next Board Meeting** – The next meeting will be on July 19<sup>th</sup>.
- **COVID-19 Update** – We are following State guidelines and are asking unvaccinated guests to Village Hall to wear a mask. No further updates at this time. There is a meeting scheduled with the Health Department next Monday.
- **Education Garden Meeting** – Public Works Director McLaughlin and I met with the Westmont Village Manager on Thursday to discuss the status of the Garden. The Westmont Environmental Committee will be meeting to discuss next steps, and we expect to determine next steps after that.
