- **Next Board Meeting** – The next meeting is on Tuesday, January 17th at 6:30 p.m. A virtual option will continue to be offered. The January 3rd meeting has been cancelled due to the holiday.
- **Village Offices Closed** –Due to the Christmas holiday, Village offices will be closed Friday, December 23rd and Monday December 26th. Offices will also be closed for the New Year's Holiday on Monday, January 2nd
- **Delayed Garbage Pickup** - Garbage collection will be postponed by one day next week due to the Christmas holiday being observed on Monday, December 26th. Residents North of the BNSF railroad tracks will have their service on Tuesday, December 27th and residents South of the BNSF railroad tracks will have their service on Wednesday, December 28th. In addition, please try to keep cans off the road if it snows, so that the plows can keep the streets clear this winter.
- **Meeting with State Representative Elect Jennifer Ladisch Douglass**– I met the new State Representative at the DMMC offices on Wednesday morning. She asked for the chance to meet with representatives of the local communities she will be representing. This provided an opportunity to relay concerns regarding issues such as LGDF funding, state mandates, and public safety issues. She pledged to continue the dialogue with local representatives.
