## **Recent Training, Meetings and Events**

- This month's Police Law online training pertains to Miranda and interrogations.
- This month's CourtSmart covers procedural justice.
- Sergeant Finrock and Sergeant Porter attended the D181 safety meeting.
- Officer Spelman is attending supervisory leadership training.
- Detective Michalek and Officer Kane participated in an active shooter exercise in Addison.
- Officers are completing bloodborne pathogen training.

## **Recent incidents:**

On August 5, 9:42pm, officers responded to unincorporated 56<sup>th</sup> St. to assist the Sheriff's Department on a domestic battery involving a barricaded subject with weapons. Officers were able to bring the children inside to safety and take the offender into custody.

On August 6, 2:22pm, officers responded to the 500 block of Carlisle for a man with a gun call. The complainant advised officers that he witnessed the offender letting the air out of his tire because he inadvertently parked in the offender's parking space. When he confronted the offender, a physical altercation ensued. Eventually, the offender went into his apartment and reemerged with a gun (later determined to be a BB gun). The offender was arrested and charge with aggravated assault and battery.

On August 7, 10:56pm, officers responded to the 10 block of Norfolk for a hit and run crash. An unknown vehicle sideswiped the victim's car while it was parked on the street. Pending.

On August 8, 3:09pm, officers stopped a motorist on 55<sup>th</sup> for speeding. It was also determined that the driver had a suspended drivers license. The driver was cited and released to a valid driver.

On August 10, 4:45am, officers responded to Rte. 83 and 55<sup>th</sup> for a vehicle crash involving a pedestrian. The pedestrian, who was struck while in the roadway, was transported to Good Samaritan Hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries. The investigation continues with the assistance of the MERIT Major Crash Team.
