Subject: Weekly Activity Report



Recent Training, Meetings and Events:

- Officer Putna attended an Active Shooter Response for Fire & Police multi-jurisdictional training exercise hosted by Bensenville.
- Officers Pech, Gerstenkorn and Sergeant Porter received in-house training with Red Dot Optics at the Lemont range.
- The final Dancin' in the Street event for 2024 took place, successfully wrapping up the centennial concert season on a high note.

Recent incidents:

August 2, 8:45am, a resident came to the station to report someone was contacting them about an alleged debt owed of which they were unaware. The resident is working with their banking institution to determine the legitimacy of the alleged debt.

August 5, 5:14pm, a resident on Holmes Ave called to report the theft of a loaf of raisin bread, 12-pack of pop and a lanyard of keys from outside their residence. Since the time of the report, the keys have been recovered, but not the raisin bread or 12-pack.

August 6, 6:56am, a vehicle was observed traveling w/b on 55th St with a registration violation. After stopping the vehicle, officers learned the driver did not have a valid license or proof of insurance. The driver was cited for no valid license, expired registration, no insurance, and the vehicle was towed.

August 6, 10:36am, officers responded to a residence after receiving a request for a well being check on a subject who the caller said sounded like they needed help. Police and Fire personnel ultimately made entry via the unlocked front door and located the subject in question who was highly intoxicated and transported to the hospital for treatment.

August 6, 8:46pm, officers responded to the residence of a subject having a mental health crisis. Upon arrival, officers assisted Fire Department personnel with calming the situation. The subject in need of assistance was transported to the hospital for treatment.

August 7, 12:07pm, a resident called to report approximately twenty dollars and a bag with cosmetics was taken from their vehicle after it was entered and rummaged through sometime overnight by unknown means. There were no signs of forced entry to the vehicle parked in the driveway. Officers are investigating.

August 8, 11:42am, a resident called to report the windows of his vehicle were broken out while parked in the complex parking lot overnight. Officers are investigating the incident.

August 8, 2:28pm, a subject came to the police department to report multiple delayed domestic battery incidents with an ex romantic partner. The subject also provided officers with a copy of an order of protection that needed to be served on the ex, which officers successfully served. Further investigation is pending.
