- **Board Meeting** – The next board meeting is Monday, July 21, at 6:30 PM at the Village Hall.
- **Richmond Education Gardens**- Jon Yeater from Westmont reached out this week and informed us that the Garden will be getting a permanent sign later this summer. We were excited to hear that Kovar Signs, a local company in Westmont, created the design and will be making the sign. The Richmond Education Gardens and Apiary is a joint venture between the Villages of Clarendon Hills and Westmont.
- **Multi-Family Parking Permits** – Notices went out from the Manager's office to the Property owners of multi-family buildings regarding the newly passed Ordinance 25-06-13 about overnight parking permits. Staff will create flyers and place them on the cars of residents in those buildings in the coming months, and signs will be installed in the designated parking spots in the fall.

1. Construction continued on the Chicago Avenue Road Project. This project includes removing the turn lane into Notre Dame and creating a four-way stop at Chicago Avenue and Coe Rd/Norfolk. This week westbound traffic was detoured to Norfolk then Prospect to allow crews to replace additional concrete panels on the south side of Chicago. Those are all poured, and traffic will be reopened on Chicago Avenue after the concrete has cured. The opening of Chicago Avenue to two-way traffic is anticipated to occur around noon on Monday. The Middaugh detour will continue through next week as there is more work to be completed on Middaugh north of the intersection.
2. Contractors continued to place backfill into the well hole at Well 7 this week. This work will wrap-up next week and then the restoration work will commence.
3. Staff worked on Dancin' in the Street on Wednesday and the Farmers Market on Thursday.
4. Drainage work was concluded on Grant. Yards were restored.
5. Ditching was completed at locations on Coe and Middaugh.
6. Chestnut alley inlets were cleaned and debris removed from the fence line.
7. Sidewalk squares were replaced on McIntosh and North Jackson.
8. Flow tests were completed at two locations.
9. Signage and set up for the Hinsdale Golf Club Swin Meet were completed.
10. Beds throughout the Downtown were watered multiple times.
11. Utility locates were completed throughout town.
12. Remote read transmitters were replaced on homes where the battery was failing.
13. Water samples were collected and taken to the lab for analysis.
14. Newly planted trees were watered throughout the week.
15. Additional trees were evaluated for removal.
16. A water main break was repaired at the corner of Hudson and Richmond.

1. **RFP:** Five Request for Proposals (RFP) were submitted by the deadline of 6/30/25 for the properties located at 316 and 318 Park Ave.
2. **Meeting:** Staff had a follow-up meeting with the proposed operator of the Prospect Tavern project.
3. **Code Enforcement:** The following code enforcement activities occurred this week:
 - 30 Block of Waverly Ave. Drainage, Staff are evaluating the issue.
 - Staff put compliance work together on several properties.
 - 4 Block of Walker, Staff evaluated building canopy.
 - 57th and Holmes, Staff reviewed overgrown bushes at location.
 - 100 Block of Indian, Staff met resident about working without a permit, issue unfounded and closed.
 - 100 Block of Hiawatha, Staff posted home for work without a permit. We received a response and staff need to evaluate the scope of work to determine if permits are necessary.
4. **ZBA/PC Regular Meeting:** The next ZBA/PC regular meeting is scheduled for August 7th. A public hearing will be held at 104 Walker Avenue and 301 Park Avenue.
5. **200 Park Ave –** Staff along with a Village Trustee and the Village Manager met virtually with the property owner and management company of 200 Park Avenue. The meeting was to discuss the various improvements the owner is planning on making to the property.

Recent Training, Meetings and Events:

- Staff participated in the Hinsdale Golf Club 4th of July Fireworks event. Overall, everything went well, and no major incidents were reported. Thank you to the Golf Club staff for their partnership in making everything run smoothly.
- Ofc. Calderon attended a First Line Supervision Fundamentals webinar online
- Staff was on scene for another Wednesday night concert that had a good turnout with positive feedback.
- Sgt Finfrock attended multiple planning meetings with D181 to get ready for this year's school safety season.
- Sgt Finfrock spoke about bike safety at the Park District's "Amazing Trike Race".
- Officers will be working the Hinsdale Golf Club's Conference Swim Finals event on Saturday.

- Sgt. Michalek assisted Willowbrook and Hinsdale Police with Drone support for a fleeing subject involved in a hit and run crash and a missing subject experiencing a mental health crisis.
- Sgt Finfrock assisted Westmont Police with Drone support for a residential burglary involving a subject that fled the scene.

Recent incidents:

On 07/05 10:15am officers responded to the 300 BLK of Ridge for a report of a suspicious circumstance. A house sitter for an out-of-town resident reported finding a rear door to the residence standing open. Officers searched the property and were unable to locate anything indicative of criminal activity and the house was secured.

On 07/05 6:58pm officers responded to a multiunit property in Downers Grove at the request of their agency for a large pool party that had become "out of control". Officers worked with surrounding towns to peacefully disperse the crowd and restore order.

On 07/06 12:43am officers stopped a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed S/B Rt. 83. The driver of the vehicle was cited for misdemeanor speed 83 in a 55mph zone.

On 07/06 9:25pm officers were dispatched to the 300blk of Holmes Ave for a subject acting strangely. Upon arrival officers spoke with the subject who had been involved in a domestic disagreement and was attempting to get a ride. Officers provided assistance and the subject was able to arrange transportation to his intended destination.

On 07/07 12:09pm officers responded to an identity theft complaint at the PD. The reporting party indicated they received a suspicious phone call posing as the "credit card" company asking for personal information. After providing the information the reporting party decided to verify the complaint with their bank who advised them they did NOT make the call. The bank was able to take precautionary measures to avoid any fraudulent charges. Case closed pending any fraudulent activity.

On 07/07 1:43pm officers responded to the 200 blk of Park Ave for a report of a fraud complaint. The reporting party indicated that they received an email from Lowes indicating a piece of furniture was ready for pickup at their Texas location. The victim related that no furniture was purchased, and they immediately notified their financial institution of the fraudulent charge. The funds were reimbursed through their bank without the victim suffering any loss. Case closed.

On 07/09 2:04am Officer stopped a vehicle traveling 98 in a 55mph zone S/B Rt. 83. Upon contact with the driver, it was learned that in addition to speeding they also had a suspended drivers license. The driver was cited on scene for the violations, and the vehicle was released to a valid driver who was a passenger of the vehicle.

On 07/10 11:12am officers responded to the 200 blk of Woodstock Ave for a complaint of identity theft. On scene, the victim related that an unknown individual who posed as the FBI contacted them alleging a breach of their personal information. After multiple calls with the individual, the victim provided personal information that resulted in a wire transfer of funds overseas. Case is pending further investigation.
