1. As a reminder, the Public Services Committee is meeting at 5:30 p.m. on Monday (before the regular Board Meeting) to discuss standards for storm water ditches around town. Materials regarding this item are included in the packet.
2. The "Committee" agenda for the July 20 Board Meeting includes the revisions to Section 2.4 of the Code (Administrative and Legislative Committee) and the police staffing ordinance (Public Safety Committee). Neither of these items have changed since the first consideration on July 6. They are included in case additional questions or proposed changes are desired.
3. The issue of Village dispatch services was discussed at the July 6 Board Meeting with the possible expectation that additional action would be sought at the July 20 Board Meeting. We now expect this to occur at the next (August 17) meeting. For your information.
4. The fifth concert in the Dancin' in the Street series took place on Wednesday. We finally had good weather, with no risk of rain and warm temperatures. The results were clear, as this was the best attended concert so far. Thanks to Talley's for acting as food vendor for the evening. July 22 is the last concert of the summer, with a performance by Libido Funk Circus. We hope for a great turn out from the community.
5. Interviews are taking place for a new Community Service Officer to fill a vacant position. The Village received dozens of applications. We hope to have the position filled by the middle of August.

1. The 2015 Water Main Improvements project is entering the home stretch. All new main line main is in place. Service transfers are continuing on Chestnut and Waverly. Testing and chlorination are underway on Waverly and McIntosh. The project is two days behind schedule, but we hope to make that up next week.
2. The 2015 Road Program contractor began construction lay-out on McIntosh, Gilbert, Blodgett, Norfolk and Middaugh this week. Culvert and storm sewer work is tentatively scheduled to begin Monday. Notices will be delivered to affected residents today.
3. We have been busy mowing and tree trimming this week. More of the same is scheduled for next week.

1. Recent events and training:

- July 14 – 17, Officer Johnson attended a 3 day DUI field sobriety instruction class.
- July 13 – 17, Detective Shirley attended a 5 day Leadership and Supervisory Skills class as part of Dupage County SWAT.
- This week, the Department hosted a NEMRT (North East Multi Regional Training) class. The topic was employee background investigations.

Significant traffic and criminal activity during the period July 11, 2015 through July 17, 2015.

1. July 11, a resident of the 100 block of Naperville Road reported they were a victim of identity theft. Someone unknown had opened a Verizon Wireless account under the victim's name and ran the account up to \$2440.00 past due.
2. July 11, a resident of Park Willow, 5705 building, reported someone had taken 4 twelve packs of diet coke, which was left in the hallway. Officers checked with other condo owners, but they did not see anyone take the items.
3. July 13, an officer responded to CHMS for a report of criminal damage to property. A CHMS staff member reported sometime over the weekend someone had placed a T-shirt over a rope used to hang banners outside of the school. The shirt had been burnt, but no other damage was done.
4. July 16, shortly after midnight, officers assisted Willowbrook Police, who were responding to a structure fire at 6340 Americana Dr., Willowbrook. Clarendon Hills officers assisted with evacuation of the building. Soon after, our officers were requested to the area of 6100 block of Knoll Valley Dr., where someone had

confronted two male offenders attempting to break into an apartment. The offenders had fled the scene prior to the officers arriving. Officers secured the scene until Willowbrook Police arrived.

This past week, officers made two traffic arrests, offenders had suspended drivers licenses.

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - Five (5) Fire Prevention Life Safety Inspections were conducted
2. Training Report:
 - Captain Mark Rediehs is updating NIMS compliance for the village.
3. Emergency Medical Services Report:
 - Wednesday evening, twenty one Firefighter/EMT-B's and Paramedics attended monthly continuing education conducted by an instructor from Loyola Medical Services System. The monthly topic was street drugs.
4. Clarendon Hills/Hinsdale FD sharing of services report:
 - No report
5. Emergency Management Report:
 - No report
6. In March the Insurance Services Offices of Illinois (ISO) visited with us all day to perform a re-rating of the Fire Protection Classification for Clarendon Hills. This rating involves the capabilities of the fire department, capabilities of the village water system and also our dispatch center. Insurance companies use this information for the calculation of insurance premiums for homeowners and larger buildings. The lower the rating number the better, with 1 being the best and 10 meaning there is no fire protection available. On July 9th I received the results of the re-rating. I was very pleased to be informed that the Fire Protection Class rating for Clarendon Hills is being lower from a four (4) to a three (3) effective on October 1, 2015. We earned 75.14 points during our rating. We are 4.86 points short of a Class Two (2) rating. Over the next few months I will be reviewing what would be needed to receive enough points in order for us to be elevated to

a Class Two (2), and to see if it economically possible. I will also be developing a press release with this information next week.

This is the third ISO rating that I have been involved in as Fire Chief. Here is a list of our past ratings which have improved each year:

1974 Class 6
1987 Class 5
2005 Class 4
2015 Class 3

I would like to thank the members of the Clarendon Hills Fire Department for their dedication to service which makes this excellent rating possible. I would also like to thank our Public Works/Water Department for their hard work keeping our water system in tip top shape. I would also like to thank the residents, Village President and Trustees for providing the necessary funds to the Fire and Water Departments to make this achievement possible.

7. On Tuesday morning I attended the monthly meeting of the DuPage County Fire Chiefs in Glendale Heights. At this meeting we were given a status report of the County Wide CAD/RMS project. I am glad to report everything is going well and it is planned to have this system up and running in 18-24 months.
8. On Thursday, Chief Farmer and I attended the monthly meeting of the SWCD Executive Committee meeting.
9. On Tuesday evening, the Fire Department Squad Truck replacement Committee met again. They are now in the final stages of the development of the specifications. It is planned to replace this 1994 vehicle in 2016 when it is 22 years old.

10. Incidents of Interest:

- Monday, July 13th at 8:53 PM. The fire department along with Hinsdale Engine 84, responded to a fire alarm which turned into an electrical problem at the Christ Lutheran Church 60 55th St. Water from heavy rains leaked into an electrical room causing a short circuit in an electrical box. Power shut off to electrical box, firefighters checked the entire building and found no other damage. We waited for a representative of the church to arrive to explain the problem to them.

11. Mutual Aid Calls:




