1. Zach Creer and I met with our ComEd government affairs representative to discuss annual reports for Clarendon Hills. In general, outages were reduced in the previous year (2014) and routine and specific maintenance programs were conducted to further reduce the risk of outages. The installation of “smart grid” meters are currently scheduled for Clarendon Hills in 2016.
2. As mentioned last week, the Village belongs to a consortium of communities working to negotiate a new standardized agreement with Nicor. I serve on the steering committee of the consortium, which met earlier this week. We remain hopeful this can be concluded this summer with a generally positive outcome.
3. As indicated in other reports, the 2015 water main and street repair program has started this week. So far it seems to be going about as well as can be expected, with some disruption of traffic. It appears that most drivers are taking it in stride and following the necessary detours. The project will continue for most of the summer.
4. On Friday, Zach Creer, Vicki Pries, and Dan Ungerleider met with Gordon Flesch to close out the Laserfiche project. Work will continue on the staff side to upload all the necessary documents.
5. Special Events Committee is now scheduled to meet next Tuesday (June 9th) at 7 pm. Everything is set for the first concert on June 17th.

1. Installation work for the 2015 Water Main Improvements project got underway this week at Burlington and Golf. The contractor is proceeding north on Golf and should reach Norfolk tomorrow or Monday. A second crew has been mobilized and will be working eastward on Chestnut from Golf. Parking restrictions have been posted and daily detours will be in place.
2. Daisy Days preparations are moving along nicely. Mulching has been completed in all planters and landscape islands in the CBD. Next week we will clean the streets, fill any holes, place the generator and place the electrical system.
3. Emerald Ash Borer treatments are nearly completed thanks to this week's dry weather. We will wrap-up our effort early next week.
4. Specifications for the annual sidewalk replacement program have been completed in anticipation of a June 23rd bid opening and a July 6th award of contract.

Subject: Weekly Activity Report

1. Recent training:

- June 1, Det. Shirley conducted a one day FIAT rifle training class. Four members of the department attended along with officers from area departments.
- June 2-4, Officer Shaw attended a three day class on interview and interrogation techniques.
- June 3-4, myself, Officer Finfrock, and Police Assistant Green attended phase one of a three phase seminar to review computer-aided dispatch and record's management systems. DuPage County Procurement Services Division sponsored the event.

Significant traffic and criminal activity during the period May 30, 2015 through June 5, 2015.

1. 6/1, officers responded to 501 Carlyle Drive for a fire alarm. Upon arrival, officers observed a large amount of smoke and flames coming from the roof of the building. The investigation revealed a plumber working above the second floor ceiling caused the fire. The plumber was using a torch to make repairs to pipes. No one living in the building were injured.
2. 6/3, an officer responded to Clarendon Eye Care, 403 Ogden, for a theft report. The owner related on May 30, 2015, sometime in the afternoon, an unknown 40 to 50 year old male white offender was hanging around the lobby looking at eye glass frames. A few days later, the staff noticed multiple frames missing in the area where the subject was looking. The estimated loss totaled over \$3000.00.
3. 6/3, a Burr Ridge women parked her vehicle in the area of Park and Prospect, when she returned to her vehicle, she noticed it had been hit by another vehicle.

The vehicle was damaged on the rear quarter panel, there were no witnesses to the hit and run.

4. 5/31, officers responded to the area of S/B Ill. Rt. 83 and the Burlington Ave bridge for a report of a subject leaning out of a vehicle vomiting. Upon arrival, there were two vehicles on the side of the road; one driven by a 31 year old Riverdale Ill. man and the other driven by a 27 year old Wheaton women. It is unknown why the vehicles were stopped on the side of the road. Both subjects were uncooperative with officers from the start. Officers smelled burnt cannabis from the vehicle driven by the male. After investigation, the male was charged with unlawful possession of cannabis and the female was charged with disobeying a police officer.
5. This past week, officers made two traffic arrests, both offenders had suspended drivers licenses.

6. Today we are all meeting to discuss dispatching options again.
7. This week a Fire Department Captain was injured at a fire when a ceiling fell on him. He was transported by ambulance and treated and released from the hospital. He is now 100% recovered. Also this week a firefighter EMT was injured at an ambulance call in a parking lot, when the FF/EMT tripped on a curb injuring her knee. She also received treatment at the hospital and expected to be fully recovered by Monday.
8. On Thursday, a new Chevrolet Staff car was delivered to the fire department. This vehicle will go to Lund in Northbrook later in the month for the installation of lights, siren, radios, computer, etc.

9. Incidents of interest:

- Monday, June 1st at 5:30 PM. The fire department responded for a fire in the attic at 501 Carlyle in the Park Willow complex. Two firefighters sustained minor injuries and were treated at the hospital and released. Damage is estimated to be more than \$1 million dollars. 
10. Mutual Aid Calls:


