The concerts continue next Wednesday (June 24) and for the next four (4) Wednesdays after that. Hope to see everybody there. Thank you to Public Works for an excellent clean up job after the concert! SUBJECT: Department Notes

1. Despite the rain and an unknown sanitary service we found, work on the 2015 Water Main Improvements project is on schedule. New main is in place between Village Hall and Notre Dame and work is progressing on Chestnut. Water service transfers will begin next week. Installation work on Norfolk between Prospect and Golf has been rescheduled to the last week of this month.
2. Along with the citizens and Chamber of Commerce, we survived a damp Daisy Days with only minor issues. We are pre-placing barricades for the Daisy Dash today and will set the port-a-johns tomorrow night.
3. We addressed a few drainage issues Monday night related to clogged inlets and ditches. We will be performing repairs on Ruby, Tuttle and Arthur next week.
4. The annual sidewalk replacement program is out to bid. Bids will be opened on June 23rd with award of contract scheduled for the July 6th Board meeting.

Subject: Department Report

1. **Department Vacations.** During the last one and a half weeks the Community Development Department has been short staffed due to summer vacations. Although we were prepared, some services have been delayed. I appreciate and thank everyone for their patience.
2. **Stormwater Management.** Early last week I met with Village Engineer Lee Fell (CBBEL) to begin coordination of individual new home construction projects north of Blue Lake to proactively address potential and existing stormwater issues in that area through new development. In practice, each project is looked at separately to insure each individual project complies with the village ordinances for design, engineering and stormwater management. As these projects progress, the Village will be working with each of these projects to reasonably address stormwater conditions in the immediate neighborhood.
3. **Proposed Prospect Av Railroad Crossing Improvements.** Earlier this year the Village applied for a grant that would support road and railroad crossing improvements around the Village's train station property. On Tuesday the Village's project management consultant and I met with representatives if the BNSF Rail Road and the Illinois Commerce Commission to discuss the improvements to the Prospect Av railroad crossing gates as is proposed in our grant application. As a result of this meeting the Village will be modifying its proposed design and will be seeking additional funding from both ICC and BNSF. Implementation of these improvements could start as soon as FY2017-2018.
4. **Richmond Education Garden's and Apiary.** Fundraising continues in support of this project (www.clarendonhills.us/sustainability.cfm). Volunteers at Daisy Days and Wednesday night's Dancin' in the Street displayed an observation bee hive and sold raw honey, lollipops and honey sticks. Local Businesses displaying the Garden Bee Logo are selling special products and services with proceeds going to the Garden. The Clarendon Hills Parks Foundation extends it thanks to retiring Police Chief Jenkins for introducing and supporting the proposed community apiary. 5. **Permit Report.** So far in June, the Village issued seventeen (17) permits having a total reported value of \$409,000.

6. On Thursday Deputy Chief Farmer attended the Southwest Central Dispatch and 911 Board executive meetings.

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - Four (4) Fire Prevention/Life Safety inspections were completed.
2. Training Report:
 - Captain Mark Rediehs is updating NIMS compliance for the village.
 - Tuesday evening, twenty one (21) firefighters attended weekly training.
3. Emergency Medical Services Report:

4. Clarendon Hills/Hinsdale FD sharing of services report:

5. Emergency Management Report:

6. On Wednesday, we hired a new part time firefighter paramedic. His name is Jason Smolinski. Jason lives in Westmont and is a full time member of the Oak Brook Terrace Fire Protection District. Welcome Jason!
7. On Thursday, Deputy Police Chief Farmer and I attended the monthly meeting of the SWCD Executive Committee. At the meeting the director explained to everyone the possible impact of the new 9-1-1 legislation in Illinois could reduce the revenue received by the SWCD 9-1-1 system by up to \$700,000 annually. Also at the meeting the next generation 9-1-1 requirements along with CAD and RMS requirements will require new systems that will be very expensive and that SWCD does not have the funds to pay for these and special assessments to pay for these may be required.

8. Incidents of interest:

- Saturday, June 13th at 5:44 PM. Ambulance 314 responded to 100 Park Avenue for a bicycle accident. One (1) injured patient transported to a local hospital.
- Monday, June 15th at 8:07 AM. The fire department was dispatched for a Metra train engine on fire across from 136 Burlington Ave. on the center track. Firefighters responded and then asked for assistance from Hinsdale Engine 1012 in extinguishing the fire in the engine compartment. Damaged to the train was estimated at more than \$100,000.
- Monday, June 15th at 11:30 PM. The fire department and Hinsdale Engine 1012 responded to a gas leak in the condominium building at 5740 Concord Lane in the Park Willow Complex. Firefighters located the leak in an unoccupied unit. The unit was also found to be used as a storage area. Code Enforcement is handling this now.
- Tuesday, June 16th at 2:22 AM. Ladder Truck 319 responded for Com Ed wires down at 414 Chicago Ave. Upon arrival firefighters found a high voltage wire on the ground and sparking. Firefighters secured the area with the assistance of police officers and waited for Com Ed to arrive. The burning/sparking wire burned a large hole in the concrete. Our Com Ed External Affairs Manager has been notified about the damage to the concrete sidewalk and driveway.
- Tuesday, June 16th at 5:23 AM. The fire department along with Hinsdale Engine 1012 responded for a smoking fire pump motor at the Clarendon Hills Middle School at 301 Chicago Ave. Upon arrival firefighters met with the maintenance personnel who had shut the power off to the pump. The fire pump was destroyed.
- Tuesday, June 16th at 11:00 AM. Ladder Truck 319 responded to Com Ed wires down in the rear of 122 Oxford. Firefighters secured the area and waited for Com Ed arrival.

9. Mutual Aid Calls:

- Saturday, June 13th at 6:42 PM. Ambulance 314 responded to assist the Hinsdale Fire Department with a vehicle accident with injuries in the southbound side of the Hinsdale Oasis on I 294. One (1) injured patient transported to a local hospital.

- The Hinsdale Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Clarendon Hills four (4) times.
- The Clarendon Hills Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Hinsdale two (2) times.
