The Village was notified by the State DCEO that our existing grant for plan development in the METRA station area has been “suspended.” This action was apparently taken by the Governor as part of the State budget crisis. We assume that suspended means it might come back, but there are no guarantees. We expect to discuss the potential impact of this with the Board at the July 6 meeting.
2. The second concert in the Dancin’ in the Street series took place on Wednesday. Attendance was good given the weather, and we managed to escape the expected rain. The next concert is on Wednesday July 1. “Jump Taxi” will be performing with a country tinge starting at about 7 p.m. Food will be provided by the Village Gourmet. Hope to see you there.

- I attended the Intergovernmental Risk Management (IRMA) Board meeting on Wednesday, where I accepted two awards on behalf of the Village of Clarendon Hills. The first was awarded to the Village as a whole for the top ranking small member in the IRMA organization for 2014. The Village ranked number 2 out of a total of 69 IRMA members for its five-year member claims experience with regard to severity, five-year claims to member contribution ratio, and its most recent IRMA Management Assessment Program (IMAP) Evaluation percentage of compliance rating. The Village scored 96% on its most recent IMAP visit. A great deal of work is involved in preparing for an IMAP visit and Zach Creer and all of the departments must be commended for their outstanding efforts.

The second award went to the Clarendon Hills Public Works Department for achieving a zero accident rate in both frequency and severity for vehicle and work injuries during 2014. This award recognizes zero accident rates in fire, police, and public works departments, and Clarendon Hills Public Works was one of only seven departments to receive this award for 2014. Congratulations to the men and woman in the Public Works Department! Well done!

- I participated in a tour of the Du-Comm dispatch center on Monday as the Village researches additional options for its Fire and Police dispatch services.

1. The 2015 Water Main Improvements project is on schedule. Installation work on Chestnut wrapped-up yesterday and work on Waverly will begin today. Water service transfers on Golf are underway.
2. We completed our Daisy Dash clean-up on Monday – it does not generate much trash, but we do need to retrieve all the barricades which were utilized. We skirted heavy rain during Dancin' in the Street, but were prepared for the possibility. A replacement door has been ordered for the refrigerated trailer.
3. Spring ditching has, finally, been completed. Given the wet spring, I believe we did as well as we could. However, we must monitor the restoration work more closely as either continued rain or substantial heat will impede the growth of grass.
4. The annual sidewalk replacement program bids were opened on Tuesday. Award of the contract is scheduled for the July 6th Board meeting.

1. **Access to Transit Improvement Program Grant.** On Monday I met with BNSF and ICC representatives to discuss the proposed rail road crossing improvements proposed in the Village's grant application. Improvements discussed include reconfiguration of the vehicle lanes crossing the tracks with the addition of shared bike lanes, replacement and relocation of the crossing gates, and reconfirmation of the sidewalks on either side of the crossing.

Yesterday the Village was informed that the State has "suspended" the funding previously granted to the Village to support the design and engineering for the above described improvement in and around the Village Commuter Station. Halting the preparation of the required engineering/design documents could be detrimental to our ability in seeking this grant funding. 2. **Richmond Education Garden's and Apiary.** On Monday evening I appeared before the Clarendon Hills Park Board with Mary Williams and John Steeves of the Clarendon Hills Park Foundation to introduce and seek support for the proposed garden and apiary. The Foundation has been the non-for-profit organization supporting activities and fund raising for the Village's award winning CHCO2 Footprint Project and the proposed Garden. At the conclusion of our presentation, the Park Board agreed to assign a Board member as a liaison on the Park Foundation Board, include information about the Foundation and Garden in the upcoming Park District Program Book and the website, and be a Garden Partner for future fundraising/grant-seeking activities.

Fundraising continues in support of this project (www.clarendonhills.us/sustainability.cfm). Volunteers at Wednesday night's Dancin' in the Street display continued to sell raw honey, lollipops and honey sticks. Don't forget to visit our local businesses displaying the Garden Bee Logo to purchase special products and services. All proceeds from these sale will support development the Garden. 3. **Historical Society.** On Wednesday morning I met with Chuck Brand at Heritage Hall to tour the facility and to discuss proposed plans to renovate and improve the Historical Society's facility at 50 Sheridan Avenue. 4. **9-27 Walker.** On Thursday afternoon Village Manager Barr and I met with the property owner and development team for the vacant property behind and south of 1 Walker Av (Scapa Restaurant). During this meeting the developer presented their development concept for the property in preparation for making a formal application for zoning and downtown design review approval. The proposed development is a multi-story mixed-use residential building. The developer plans to appear before the Zoning Board of Appeals/Plan Commission later for Concept Review in July or August. There are no plans on file at this time.
5. **Permit Report.** So far in June, the Village issued twenty-nine (29) permits having a total reported value of \$496,897.

6. Ambulance 314 stood by at the Daisy Dash on Sunday. One (1) patient was treated at the scene by Paramedics.
7. On Sunday, June 21st, Ambulance 314 and Truck 319 attended a car show at the Christian Church of Clarendon Hills 5750 Holmes Ave.
8. On Monday, June 22nd, Village Staff from the Fire, Police, Administration and Finance Departments attended a presentation and tour of the Du-Comm communications facility in Glendale Heights.
9. On Thursday, June 25th, representatives of Du-Comm visited the fire station and water tower communications site to evaluate what work will needed to be done on the technology side if a move to Du-Comm is approved.

10. Incidents of interest:

- Friday, June 19th at 5:10 PM. Ambulance 314 and Heavy Duty Rescue Squad 316 responded to a vehicle accident with injuries on Rt. 83 southbound at the BNSF bridge. One (1) patient transported to a local hospital.
- Sunday, June 21st at 8:28 AM. One (1) runner from the Daisy Dash passed out and treated at the scene by paramedics.
- Sunday, June 21st at 1:00 PM. Ambulance 314 and Heavy Duty Squad 316 responded for a vehicle accident with injuries on 55th St. at Holmes Ave. One (1) patient transported to a local hospital.
- Wednesday, June 24th at 4:40 PM. The fire Department along with Hinsdale Engine 85 responded for a structure fire at a single family home at 215 Holmes Ave. Upon arrival firefighters found heavy fire conditions showing. A still alarm was called which brought in assistance from Hinsdale, Western Springs, Tri State and Westmont to the scene. A Darien Woodridge Engine and a Downers Grove ambulance were placed in our fire station to cover Clarendon Hills during this incident. Damage to the home is more than \$300,000. The cause of the fire is under investigation at this time.
- Wednesday, June 24th at 10:06 PM. Firefighters responded for Carbon Monoxide alarms and heavy odors in a home at 272 N. Jackson St. Firefighters found that many wood floors were finished in this house and that was the cause of the odors. Ventilations fans were placed in the house for 30 minutes to ventilate.


11. Mutual Aid Calls:


