1. I attended a press conference downtown on Monday hosted by the DuPage Mayors and Managers Conference (DMMC) along with other neighboring organizations. The purpose was to make clear municipal concerns regarding potential loss in revenue due to potential cuts to the LGDF (income tax distribution). The event was well attended and I think helped to voice the concern that Clarendon Hills shares with virtually all municipalities in Illinois. The Board will be discussing a resolution to support maintaining the LGDF at the meeting on May 4.
2. The new budget year (FY 2015-16) begins today. The auditors conducted some preliminary work on closing out the previous fiscal year and were impressed with the job our Finance Department staff did in preparing the necessary materials.
3. I attended a meeting on Wednesday with neighboring Managers and Administrators. The purpose of the meeting was to maintain dialogue and seek out ways to reduce costs and/or improve services for our residents. We expect these meetings to continue on a periodic basis.
4. Along these lines, we are continuing to investigate the best way to provide public safety dispatch services including seeking input from alternative providers. We expect to have additional information available on this in the next month or two.
5. Dancin' in the Street planning continues; this week the Village secured another sponsorship. Thank you Village Veterinary Practice!
6. On May 8th and May 9th, IRMA will be performing its IMAP certification for the Village. The last time the Village was audited onsite was 2009. Full compliance allows for lower insurance rates and hopefully lower liability losses. The Safety Committee met again on Monday to prepare for the audit.
7. Preparation for the new document management system continued this week. After receiving State approval, staff removed over 100 bankers' boxes of irrelevant, duplicate, or already scanned files. Transition to the new document management software is expected to start on May 15th.
8. With the nice weather, it's almost time to plant our flowers downtown. The Village is still looking for 6 more sponsors. Contact Vicki Pries at vprises@clarendonhills.us or go to the Village website.

Subject: Department Report

1. **Richmond Gardens and Apiary.** On Monday afternoon I met with Mary Williams and 5 teachers from Walker School to discuss the School's potential support and involvement with the proposed education garden to be located west of the Public Works Facility. The teachers are excited and are looking for ways to include this project in their upcoming curriculum. The presentation shared at this meeting can be found at www.clarendonhills.us/sustainability.cfm.
2. **Scouting Breakfast.** On Tuesday morning Village Manager Kevin Barr and I attended a Scouting Fundraiser breakfast in Hinsdale. During the event he and I had the opportunity to meet with several community leaders from both Hinsdale and Clarendon Hills.
3. **Sloan Community Information Sign.** This week I meet with several sign companies to research potential digital alternatives to the current banner program on the Sloan Triangle sign. This item will be brought before the Village Board late spring/early summer.
4. **Stormwater Harvesting.** On Thursday I met with Kevin McClain of Southside Landscaping to investigate stormwater harvesting and detention systems that could be implemented on both public and private property. He reported that his most recent installed system harvests 100% stormwater collected onsite for irrigation. Information pamphlets about the Village's revised stormwater ordinance and different methods for collecting and harvesting stormwater are available in the Village Hall lobby.

Note - November 3, 2014 Ordinance requiring onsite stormwater storage for new impervious surfaces greater than 300 square feet becomes effective on May 1, 2015 (visit www.clarendonhills.us/stormwater.cfm for more information).

5. **Permit Report.** In April the Village issued thirty-one (31) permits, including three (3) homes, having a total value of \$1,582,095.

4. School lock down drills were held this week at Notre Dame and Clarendon Hills Middle School.
5. Officer Finfrock drove up on this car fire while on patrol on Rt. 83 near Ogden Avenue. Fortunately, there were no injuries but the car and contents were a total loss.
6. 2015/16 Village stickers go on sale Monday, May 4th at the Clarendon Hills Police Station and Village Hall. A passenger car sticker is the same as last year, \$40.00.




Significant traffic and criminal activity during the period April 24, 2015 through April 30, 2014

1. April 25th kicked off our campaign to focus on distracted driving and seat belt usage. Grant money has been used to staff additional officers on patrol and

concentrate on cell phone and seat belt violations. In an eight hour period this week 10 seatbelt and 17 cell phone citations were issued. Because our goal is to garner compliance and not issue tickets the Department passed out flyers, issued press releases and posted social media and website messages in advance of our enforcement efforts.


