

SUBJECT: Department Notes

1. The 2015 Road Program is progressing rapidly. The east side of Middaugh now has its concrete shoulder with the east sides of McIntosh, Blodgett and Gilbert scheduled to begin next Tuesday. Storm sewer work is underway on both sides of Prospect. The east side work will continue through the next two weeks.
2. The process of investigating slow drainage concerns along Iroquois south of Norfolk is underway. CBBEL will perform a survey of the culvert and storm sewer system in the next few weeks which will provide us more information to help address the situation.
3. Homer Tree Service is in town performing tree removals. We anticipate two more weeks for completion. Our crew is following close behind and filling the stump holes.
4. We will resume mowing next week and have two culvert replacements to perform.

Recent events and training:

- Detective Shirley attended FIAT SWAT training.
- August 25, Officer Shaw attended a NEMERT class regarding Craig's List crime Investigation.
- This week began a new school year, officers monitored Prospect, Walker, and Notre Dame School crossings, and will do so throughout the year.
- August 24, Officers Laird, Pasteris, and Finfrock helped with the Walker School Bike Rodeo. 30 to 40 bikes were registered.

Significant traffic and criminal activity during the period August 22, 2015 through August 28, 2015.

August 25, an officer responded to PNC Bank for a report of hit and run. The Westmont women related she parked her vehicle in the bank lot, and when she returned her vehicle was damaged. The driver's side wheel well was dented with white paint transfer.

August 26, a resident of the 300 block of Columbine came into the station to make a theft report. She reported sometime between August 22 - 23, someone unknown had entered her back yard and taken two wooden bird feeders and a hummingbird feeder.

August 26, a Clarendon Hills resident came into the station to report his bicycle stolen from the train station bike racks. The bike was a silver "Specialized Rockhopper" valued under \$500. The Metra camera showed a M/W wearing a dark shirt and a ball cap cut the lock and ride the bike E/B Burlington Ave.

August 26, officers responded to the 10 block of Iroquois Dr. for a domestic battery. The 44 year old Clarendon Hills female victim was battered by her 44 year old husband who currently lives in Berwyn. The husband had fled the scene before police arrived. August 27, officers secured a warrant for his arrest. The husband

turned himself in at the station. He was charged with two counts of domestic battery, processed, and transported to DuPage County Jail.

August 27, a Clarendon Hills resident came into the station to make an identity theft report. Someone unknown had compromised her Verizon Wireless account and charged \$494.20 in calls to her account.

August 27, an officer responded 5600 block of Holmes Ave. for a theft of motor vehicle. The Clarendon Hills resident reported she believed the car was taken by a relative. The subsequent investigation confirmed a relative did take the vehicle. The 27 year old male crashed the vehicle in Chicago and was arrested by Chicago Police Department.

August 22 through the 28, officers have been enforcing the Village sticker ordinance. Numerous citations have been issued. Apartment and condo areas have been patrolled by the officers working nights, resulting in the majority of the tickets.


8. Mutual Aid Calls:


