**Recent events and training:**

- May 9, Officer's Talerico and Laird attended "Evidence Property Management" training sponsored by the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy.
- May 10, Officer Talerico, along with other members of Hinsdale School District 181 Crisis Committee, presented an informational program to parents regarding how the school would respond in crisis situations.

**Significant traffic and criminal activity during the period May 6, 2016 through May 13, 2016.**

May 6, 11:32 pm, while on patrol, an officer observed a bike parked under the Ill. Rt. 83 bridge at Burlington Ave. The officer investigated further and found two juveniles smoking cannabis in the wooded area near Jackson Ave. The juveniles ran from the officer, leaving behind book bags and their bikes. May 7, an officer met a resident at the station regarding a domestic situation. The officer talked with all parties involved and determined the circumstances were civil and should be addressed at that level.

May 12, 3:10 pm, officers responded to the area of Chase Dr. and Holmes Ave. for a report of an aggravated assault. A witness reported seeing a confrontation between a 39 year old male Hispanic and two male blacks. The witness observed one of the male blacks displayed a pocket knife. At this point the witness yelled at the group, which caused them to flee. After locating the victim, officers attempted to talk with the 39 year old Hispanic but he refused to cooperate and did not want to press charges.

May 12, 10:11 pm, officers assisted the Fire Department in the 100 block of Indian Dr. for a dryer fire. The fire was extinguished by the officer and Fire Department personnel. Approximately \$5,000.00 damage was done to the area in the house.

1. Work on the 2016 Water Main Replacement Program has been delayed by two days. Water service transfers are nearly complete. Storm sewer work is underway.
2. The 2016 Road Improvement Program is on schedule to begin the week of May 16<sup>th</sup>. Work is still planned to start on Harris, Hudson, Ridge and Ruby.
3. Village-wide tree planting is underway. The Conestoga Sugar Maple on Holmes Avenue that was mentioned at the last Board meeting has been moved.
4. We have added seven culvert replacements to this year's program which will be completed this week. The restoration will be included with the Road Program.
