1. The 2016 Road Improvement Program is progressing rapidly. New concrete shoulders are in place on both sides of Harris, Hudson Ridge and Ruby (east of Western). Shoulder has been installed on the first side of Western, Richmond, Colfax and Ruby (west of Western). Three-quarters of the currently affected residents have had access to their driveways restored. Next week, we will complete the remaining driveway aprons and continue with storm sewer and ditch work. Westmont will be replacing water main on the west side of Richmond over the next two weeks and the Flagg Creek Water Reclamation District will be performing a short main replacement on Richmond adjacent to our building shortly thereafter. We will wait until after the 4th of July holiday weekend to begin the grinding and paving process. The project is ahead of schedule.
2. We have assisted in expediting the Road Program by replacing two dozen culverts in-house over the last two weeks.
3. As I write this, we are finalizing our Daisy Days preparations. Prospect will be closed starting at noon and we will move in the electrical system as the carnival and exhibitors are setting-up.
4. We will begin prep work for the Richmond Garden Apiary next week, which will consist of turf removal and gravel placement ahead of the Eagle Scout candidate's fence and hive project.
