1. **55th Street Sub-Area Plan** - Last Monday the Village Board approved a resolution directing Staff to enter a contract for services with Teska Associates for the development the 55th Street Sub-Area Plan, a component of the village comprehensive plan for the incorporated and unincorporated areas south of 55th Street, west of S. Kingery Highway (IL-Rt. 83), east of Richmond Avenue, and north of 59th Street. The proposed study will update and build upon the 1991 comprehensive plan for this area to specifically address: 1) economic development and opportunities for public/private investment, 2) potential annexation and expansion of municipal services of unincorporated properties, and 3) completion of currently incomplete infrastructure systems. Plans for scheduling a project kick off meeting are underway.
2. **88 Park Avenue** - On June 8 the Village filed its response to the appeal of judgement for the 88 Park Avenue lawsuit, Susan Hanlon and Philip Altvater v. Village of Clarendon Hills and 88 Park Avenue LLC case. Originally the plaintiffs had until June 22 to respond; they have since requested and had been granted an extension to July 1, 2016. As previously reported, we anticipate that a decision regarding the appeal should be known within 90-120 days after the plaintiffs' response is filed.
3. **Permits**. So far in June the Village has issued thirty-one (31) building permits, including two (2) new homes, having a total reported construction value of \$1,205,622.

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - Six (6) Fire and Life safety Inspections were conducted
 - Nineteen (19) Pre-plans were entered into our electronic data base
2. Training Report:
 - Training Officer Captain Mark Rediehs is working with Western Springs on a firefighter training certification class that might begin in January for our five (5) newer recruits.
 - Tuesday evening, twenty one (21) firefighters attended weekly regular training.
3. Emergency Medical Services Report:
 - No report.
4. Clarendon Hills/Hinsdale FD sharing of services report:
 - This week we were working together to maximize our response/sharing guidelines with Du-Comm.
 - We are also working on a joint procedure for the activation of severe weather outdoor warning sirens.
5. Emergency Management Report:
 - This week severe weather was forecasted several times. The situation was monitored and preparations were made. Thankfully no severe weather occurred in this area.
6. Yesterday, I was notified that we have been awarded an \$11,365 grant from IRMA for 1/3 of the cost of our EMS power loading and power cot system. This equipment is proven to reduce back injuries to EMT's and Paramedics and this is why IRMA is providing these grants. The power cot and loading system are a part of the new ambulance we purchased in late 2014 at a cost of approximately \$34,000.
7. On Tuesday, on duty fire department personnel visited the Clarendon Hills Park District day camp with Ladder 86 and Medic 86. Tours of the equipment along with a squirt from the fire hose to cool the kids off. Today, on duty fire personnel will attend a portion of the Clarendon Hills Park District "Touch a Truck" event. Ladder 86 and Medic 86 will attend for about 90 minutes.

8. Incidents of Interest:

- Sunday, June 19th at 12:24 PM. Medic 86 and Ladder 86 responded to a vehicle accident with injuries on 55th St. at Holmes Ave.
- Monday, June 20th at 8:02 AM. Medic 86 and Squad 86 responded to a vehicle accident with injuries on 55th St. at Virginia Ave.
- Wednesday, June 22nd at 8:26 AM. Ladder 86 responded for a small fire on the BNSF tracks near Tuttle Ave. Fire extinguished quickly.

10. Fire/Rescue/EMS calls:

- The Hinsdale Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Clarendon Hills two (2) times.
- The Clarendon Hills Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Hinsdale four (4) times.
