1. **56th Street Sub-Area Plan.** Last Tuesday the department heads had a join project kick-off meeting with the project's consultant team. Afterwards Zach Creer and I took the consultant team on a tour of the planning study area. Special thanks to The Birches for lending us a bus and driver for the tour. Next steps will include establishing a steering committee, identifying stakeholders, cataloging pertinent information resources, and developing a public engagement program. 2. **Legat Think Tank Event/Explore Biophilic Building Design.** On Thursday afternoon Trustee Greg Jordan, ZBA/PC Commissioner Annie Horton Krug attended a program hosted by Legat Architects. The program explored integrating nature in the built environment. The program featured the Village of Clarendon Hills recently drafted streetscape and roadway improvement plans around the train station. Five Legat architects presented designs concepts for a new bike shelter on Burlington Avenue. I joined five other design professionals in picking the best of the five. These five concept designs will be on display next week in Village Hall.
3. **Green Audit.** On Wednesday SCARCE conducted a green audit of the Village's municipal buildings. Their report will help the Village earn its Earth Flag. 4. **Permits.** So far in July the Village has issued nineteen (19) building permits, including two (2) new homes, having a total reported construction value of \$987,378.

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - Four (4) Fire/Life Safety Inspections were conducted this week.
 - Several pre-plan drawings were entered electronically this week.
2. Training Report:
 - Tuesday evening, eighteen (18) firefighters participated in regular evening fire suppression training. This week it was for hose relays and hydrant hook ups.
3. Emergency Medical Services Report:
 - No report.
4. Clarendon Hills/Hinsdale FD sharing of services report:
 - No report.
5. Emergency Management Report:
 - With the extreme heat this week, we dusted off our cooling center lists for the village.
 - Thursday evening heavy rain and windy conditions occurred. No significant flooding incidents were reported. Electricity from ComEd was out from 9:19 PM to 11:09 PM in the village for the area bounded by Burlington to Ogden and Golf to Warwick in Westmont. About 850 Clarendon Hills customers were without electricity for the almost 2 hour period.
6. On Monday we began our annual maintenance of all fire apparatus with Ladder 86 being transported to Wirs Industries in McHenry. While there Ladder 86 will get a complete Chassis maintenance, ladder maintenance, pump maintenance and generator maintenance. The Ladder will be tested by UL at their location also. We expect to bring this vehicle back next week. This vehicle is now 15 years old and as it gets older more and more maintenance is required.

 - Saturday, July 16th at 9:31 PM. Medic 86 and Squad 86 responded for a vehicle accident with injuries on 55th St at Prospect Ave.
 - Sunday, July 17th at 6:44 PM. Engine 86, Medic 86 and Chief 86 responded for a lamp post on fire at 11 Indian Drive. Fire extinguished quickly. Gas shut off to lamp.

- Tuesday, July 19th at 9:59 AM. Engine 86 and Medic 86 responded for a gasoline leak and wash down at 120 Chicago Ave.
- Thursday, July 21st at 5:18 PM. Medic 86 and Squad 86 responded for a vehicle accident with injuries on Rt. 83 southbound south of Ogden Ave.
