Subject: Weekly Report

1. **DMMC Manager's Committee Meeting:** On Thursday morning I attended this meeting in Oakbrook. Amongst items discussed were the intergovernmental effort led by the County to create a new emergency services record management system (delayed), on-going concerns regarding income tax distribution by the Illinois Dept. of Revenue (still trying to gather info) and a presentative by the Executive Director of IMET. In regard to the latter, she reported that we still anticipate receiving a minimum of about 48% back on the monies lost in the 2013 fraud case with payment expected sometime later this year. There are still efforts underway to increase the percentage returned. The delay in payback is due to a claim by the Federal Government, which is being worked through by the attorneys. In any case, as a reminder, the Village has NOT budgeted any return on this lost investment.
2. **Oxford Avenue Traffic Information:** Following up on the discussion from the last Board meeting, attached is information gathered from our traffic monitoring equipment on the stretch of Oxford, north of Chicago Avenue. There is a lot of data, but the bottom line is that the average speed for the period (one-week) was 22.2 MPH, which does not seem particularly excessive. We are planning to review/prepare the same report for other streets coming off of Ogden as a point of comparison. Also attached are copies of the March calendars used by the Police Department to specify areas for traffic enforcement emphasis. In this case, it notes Oxford Avenue.
3. **Executive Session Minutes Review:** We are again planning to review executive session minutes at the meeting on March 6th. The goal is to be able to prepare the appropriate resolution for adoption at the March 20th Meeting.

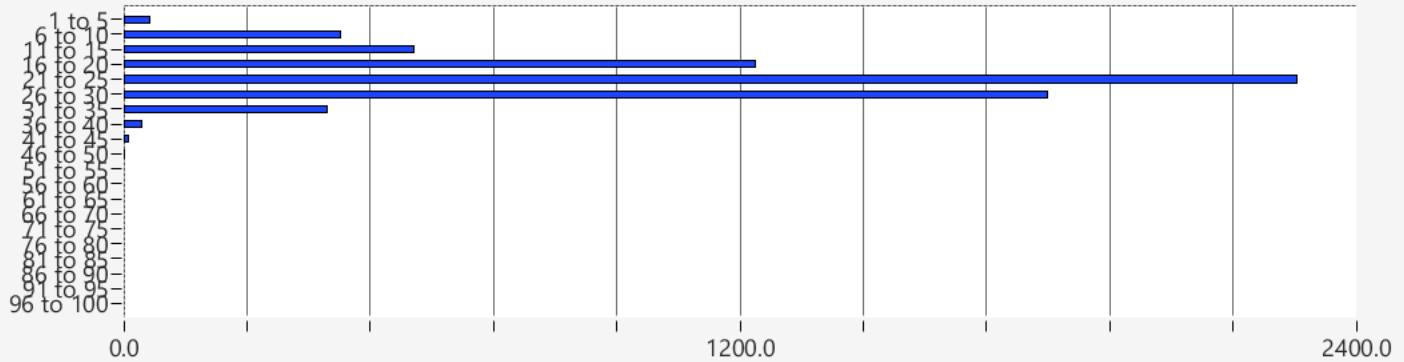

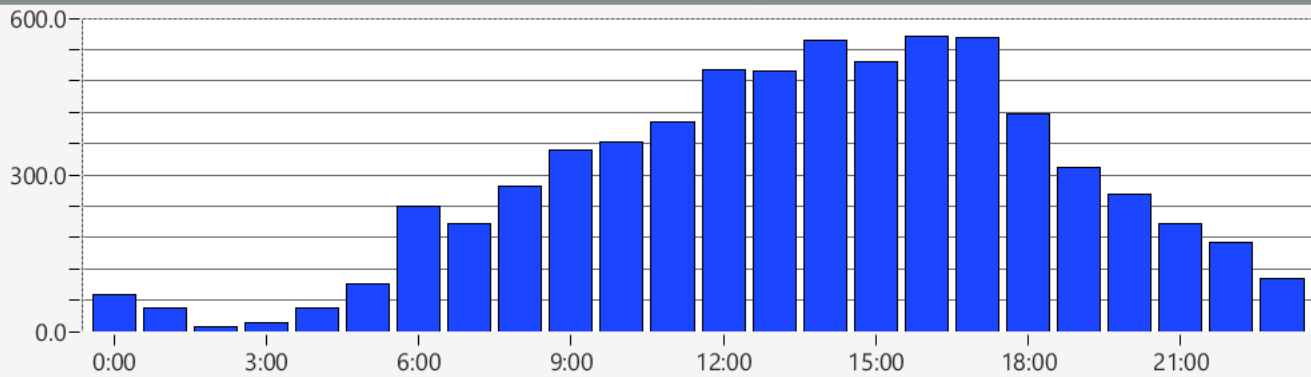

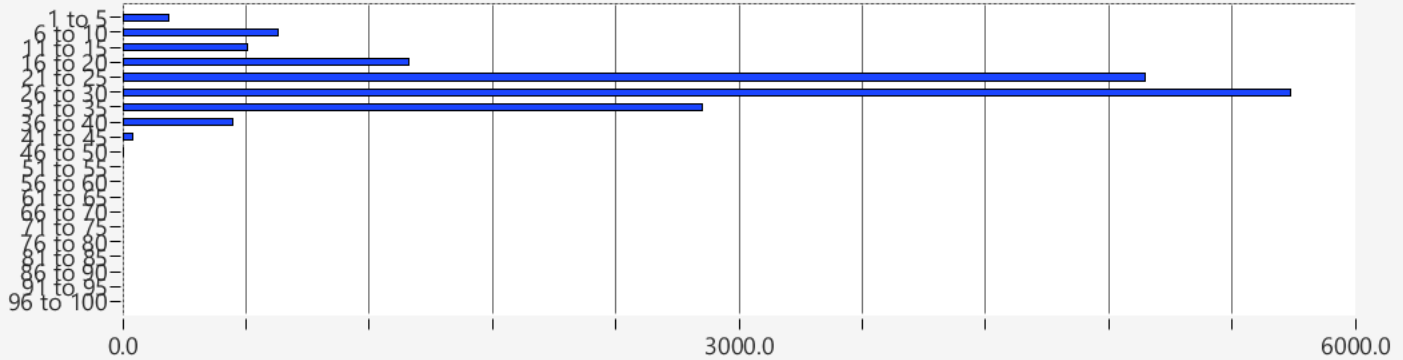

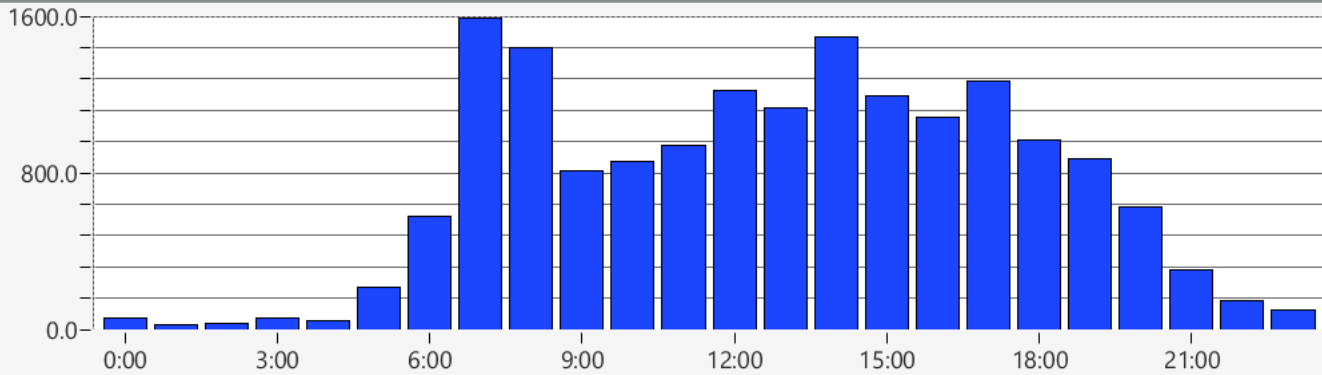

Subject: Weekly Department Report 2017-04

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - No report.
2. Training Report:
 - Wednesday evening drill was attended by thirty one (31) firefighters. Classroom training on tactics and strategy.
3. Emergency Medical Services Report:
 - All Paramedics have performed and completed their in service training for our new King Vision video Laryngoscopes. These video scopes will assist our paramedics with the placement of endotracheal tubes in patients for breathing. These scopes make this difficult task easier and quicker resulting in better patient care. The King Vision Laryngoscopes have been placed in full service on Medic 86 and Ladder 86 which also carries a complete set of ALS gear.
4. Clarendon Hills/Hinsdale FD sharing of services report:
 - No report.
5. Emergency Management Report:
 - No report this week.
6. Many hours were spent this week preparing radio programming templates and also labels for our planned move of the Clarendon Hills and Hinsdale Fire Departments from the Fire South network to the Fire East network within Du-Comm. This is all a part of channel re-alignment in DuPage County related to consolidations. Fire East Transmitters will be placed in Clarendon Hills and Hinsdale for good radio and pager coverage. This move and cutover is planned for April 5, 2017 at 10:00 AM.
7. On Wednesday, Lt. Godek attended a meeting at Du-Comm with representatives of Du-Comm Tyco/ADT and Du-Comm fire departments to discuss the alarm system move to the new facility. Many other details were covered regarding standard alarm system protocols.

8. On Thursday, I met with our Pierce Manufacturing Sales representative to go over more details regarding some minor change orders on the Heavy Duty Rescue Truck that is on order. I will have more details for you on this in the next week or two. At this time the vehicle is still scheduled for completion in October of this year.
9. I am in the process of requesting reimbursement of all of our expenses related to the move of the fire and police dispatch services from SWCD to DUCOMM. We are working out some final details with representatives of DUCOMM and the ETSB.
10. Incidents of Interest:
 - No significant calls of interest occurred.
11. Mutual Aid Calls:
 - One (1) Clarendon Hills ambulance assist to Tri State FPD
 - One (1) Clarendon Hills ambulance assist to Pleasantview FPD
12. Fire/Rescue/EMS calls:
 - The Hinsdale Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Clarendon Hills two (2) times.
 - The Clarendon Hills Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Hinsdale two (2) times.
 - During the past week, the fire department responded to fifteen (15) emergency calls.
