Subject: Weekly Report

- 1. Du-Comm Groundbreaking:** Chief Leahy, Finance Director Potempa and I attended the groundbreaking for the new facility on Monday. It is location at the DuPage County government center using, in part, existing facilities. This is an example of intergovernmental cooperation leading to reduced costs for all involved (more than 40 agencies). The facility is expected to open for use in 2018.
- 2. DMMC Manager's Committee Meeting:** I attended this meeting on Thursday morning. The primary topic of conversation was the status of another joint service project – consolidation of emergency service record service management functions. This is expected to provide cost savings for involved communities AND more efficient flow of information throughout the County. Progress is being made towards a final IGA to be reviewed and approved by each community. We currently anticipate this being done sometime this summer.
- 3. SB 1335:** There are many pieces of legislation being considered in Springfield. I wanted to bring one, SB 1335, to your attention because of its potential impact. It is described as follows:

Amends the Downstate Firefighter Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Requires a unit of local government that employs a firefighter who is a full-time firefighter in a different downstate firefighter pension fund to make specified contributions to that downstate firefighter pension fund. Requires a specified additional contribution to the pension fund from that firefighter's primary employer. Establishes reporting requirements. Authorizes the State comptroller to intercept State funds in the event the unit of local government does not make its required contribution to the primary employer's downstate pension fund. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement. Effective immediately.

Reports suggest this could cause Clarendon Hills, and other communities that use part-time firefighters and paramedics, to pay as much as 25% (including an employee share) more than we do now. DMMC has come out against this Bill. I have also notified our House Representative that we are opposed. The Bill is currently being heard in the House.

4. **Water Main Project Beginning:** The water main project in the Traube/Naperville Road area has begun this week. This is expected to have less impact than previous projects because of its reduced scope.

5. **Garbage Rates:** Garbage rates will be increasing July 1st, by the contractual minimum of 2% plus the \$0.02 cent increase for new Cook County taxes. The new monthly curbside residential pickup rate will be \$21.45. As a reminder, last year's increase was waived in exchange for changing our garbage day.
