Subject: Weekly Report

- 1. Drainage Work on Waverly:** This project is underway and is expected to be completed shortly. The goal of the project is to improve drainage of the chronic low spot that exists in the public right-of-way in front of 35 Waverly.
- 2. DMMC Manager's Committee Meeting:** I attended this meeting on Thursday morning. Various issues were discussed, including the status of the joint CAD/RMS system and preliminary steps to create intergovernmental agreements between the County and municipalities to facilitate emergency management response.
- 3. Park District Meeting re: Facilities and Operations:** On Wednesday Mike Millette and I met with Park District staff to discuss preliminary plans to construct a storage facility for the District on our Public Works site. The intent is to allow for longer term storage on this site resulting in a smaller facility on the Prospect Park site. This would allow the District to maintain needed parking and reduce the impact on the Park. Site plans will be submitted for review by staff and the Village Board. We also agreed to monitor operations, particularly snow removal, this upcoming winter so we can evaluate ways to provide efficiencies in future years.
- 4. Sloan Triangle Public Information Sign:** The Village Board reviewed a proposal for installation of a modernized Triangle sign at the meeting on Tuesday night. There was much discussion, and general support for the idea. The Board asked that something similar to the proposed sign be brought on site to allow for visual review prior to a final decision being made. We will advise when this is arranged.
- 5. Fire Department Open House:** We've started to advertise the Fire Dept. Open House which will be held October 7th from 11 AM to 2 PM. This year's open house will feature a blood drive along with a visit from Sparky the Fire Dog! The flyer for this event is attached.

1. The landscape subcontractor for the 2017 Road Program will continue to place sod today and tomorrow. Surface asphalt is scheduled for next week. The project is still on schedule for its September 29th completion. Nicor's contractor has completed the gas main replacement on Naperville between Richmond and Woodstock and will begin transferring services next week.
2. We are continuing to grind (as necessary) and fill and seed stump holes from this year's tree removals. We anticipate completing this effort in two weeks.
3. Fall banners are in place and we continue to water the plantings in the CBD.
4. Our leak detection consultant was in town this week. They found and we repaired a leaking watermain valve yesterday.

1. **Sloan Triangle Public Information Sign.** Materials and a proposal for installation of a digital public information sign was introduced to the Village Board last Tuesday evening. During the meeting the Village Board requested that a day-long demonstration be setup at the sign location. Staff is working with the sign company to schedule the demo for one-day next week. More information will be posted when a demo date has been arranged.
2. **Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance Amendment.** On Tuesday night, the Village Board approved a consultant service agreement with Camiros to assist the Village with a comprehensive review and amendment of the Village's Zoning Ordinance. The intent of this project is to identify and correct legal conflicts and deficiencies in the Zoning Ordinance, to modernize the ordinance as a whole, and to ensure its language is user-friendly. 3. **Williams Court.** This week the developer began the installation of the Village's first permeable brick-paved road. This represents the first of many 'green' infrastructure improvements planned for this development. Williams Court will be an 8 home community featuring a permeable paved street, driveways, patios, rain gardens and underground stormwater storage. These improvements were done entirely with private funding from the developer and will help retain, store, convey and clean stormwater from the surrounding area while enhancing the aesthetic. Williams Court is just South of Ogden Ave, off of Woodstock.
4. **Permits.** The monthly permit report for August is posted at www.clarendonhills.us/bp. So far in September the Village issued 4 permits having a total reported construction value of \$44,600.

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Zombie Hunting Permits. It's hard to believe Halloween is right around the corner and Zombie Hunting season is approaching. Next week the Village of Clarendon Hills Community Development Department **2017/2018 Zombie Hunting Permits** will be on sale at Village Hall for a minimum \$10.00 donation. All proceeds will be donated to the American Red Cross to help those who have been effected by devastation of Hurricane & Tropical Storm Harvey.

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - Fire Prevention Officer Lt. Dave Godek worked with several property owners and Tyco this week with some fire alarm system problems. Several were brought back into full working order.
 - Many hours were devoted to the work on the fire prevention open house coming on October 7th.
 - All school fire inspections have been completed. School fire drills are being done this week and next week.
2. Training Report:
 - Wednesday evening, twenty five (25) firefighters attended training. Pumping operations and hoses were done.
3. Emergency Medical Services Report:
 - No report.
4. Clarendon Hills/Hinsdale FD sharing of services report:
 - No report.
5. Emergency Management Report:
 - School District 181 Crisis manuals were updated and distributed to each school this week.
6. Du-Comm Report:
 - This week Du-Comm radio technicians installed a new backup VHF Fire East Transmitter in Clarendon Hills. This backup transmitter is connected and simulcasted with the other backup transmitter located in Elmhurst. These back up transmitters automatically are used in the event of a failure of the main transmitters. This is just an example of the high level of redundancy that Du-Comm provides for all of its members.
 - This week I met with a Du-Comm IT person to fine tune the mapping and addresses for Clarendon Hills.
7. The new Heavy Duty Rescue Squad Truck 86 was completely outfitted by firefighters, training conducted, and was placed into full service on Monday, August 28th.
8. This week the Fire Department CY operating budget was submitted to the Finance director.

9. The Lions Pool Emergency Gate malfunctioned over the weekend. After using it the gate would not close. The gate repair company replaced a sensor on Wednesday and the gate was back in full service. This gate is used for the Clarendon and Hinsdale Fire and Police Departments as a fast access between the south sides of the two villages for emergency calls.
10. This weekend on duty firefighters will be attending three (3) block parties with Ladder 86 and Medic 86.
11. Incidents of Interest:
 - Friday, September 1st at 7:21 AM. Ladder 86 responded for a vehicle on fire on Rt. 83 southbound south of 55th St.
 - Wednesday, September 6th at 8:25 AM. Ladder 86 and Medic 86 responded for a person trapped in an elevator at 115 55th St.
 - Mutual Aid Calls: 1 Ambulance to Hinsdale and 1 ambulance to Westmont this week.
12. Fire/Rescue/EMS calls:
 - The Hinsdale Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Clarendon Hills three (3) times.
 - The Clarendon Hills Fire Department responded Automatic Aid to Hinsdale fire (5) times.
 - During the past week, the fire department responded to nineteen (19) emergency calls.
