1. **Development Update.** Thanks to the hard work of **88 Park**'s general contractor, the sidewalks, street lights/banners, landscaping and planters have been installed in time for Daisy Days. Tree grates, pergola and corner planter landscaping are on the list to be installed. The Department is prepared to issue permits for the individual residences once the shell has been completed.

**229 Park** is preparing for occupancy with the next two weeks. The Department is insisting that all improvements are completed by the developer before a certificate of occupancy is issued. **Moda Eye Care** at 225 Park (retail space in 229 Park) is planning to open in early July.

**Band & Wire Orthodontics**' remodel of 433 Ogden is close to completion and preparing for a formal ribbon cutting early-evening on June 25<sup>th</sup>.

**Root & Bloom Chiropractic** is planning to open its doors at 140 Burlington Avenue on July 9<sup>th</sup>. Root & Bloom will provide prenatal and pediatric chiropractic, and family wellness services.

**Recent events and training:**
