8. On Wednesday, June 28th one of our firefighter paramedics was exposed to bodily fluids from a patient that he was treating. The exposure was to his eyes, nose and mouth. The Paramedic was checked out by ER doctors and the affected areas were cleaned. The hospital will be testing the patient for any infectious diseases.
