Public Works Department Staff did a great job setting up and cleaning up after all the events last weekend and this week.

4. **IRMA Meeting** – Peter Nickell, Assistant to the Village Manager, attended the quarterly Board of Directors IRMA meeting earlier this week. It included voting on bylaw amendments and auto liability cover changes.
5. **Recycling Extravaganza** – Peter Nickell met with SCARCE, a non-profit who works on recycling issues with the County, and representatives of Senator Glowiak's office to discuss a 'Recycling Extravaganza' event in the Village. The purpose of the event is to give residents an opportunity to dispose of recyclable items to various vendors who will put them to good use. The event is scheduled for Saturday, September 14th at 9:00 AM. More information will be available as the date of the event gets closer.
6. **Planting Partners** – The English Garden was able to get the summer plantings in the beds within the downtown business district prior to Daisy Days and the Daisy Dash last weekend. We look forward to seeing the beds bloom over the summer.

1. NICOR has moved into the next phase of their Gas Main Replacement Project. They are installing service lines up to the homes. A separate crew will make the final connection to the home. New gas mains have been completed north of 55th Street with the exception the area at Park and Prospect running east down Eastern and then Harris east of Holmes. This work is awaiting additional permits and is planned for installation in early Fall. Crews have begun installing service lines to the homes where the new main has been installed. 2. The 2019 Road Program started this week. Crews began drainage improvements starting at Walker and 55th Street heading north to Hudson. They also completed work on Walker south of Harris. They will return to complete work in the gap area. Details related to drainage work is included on the Village's website at www.clarendonhills.us/SSA2019
3. Public Works crews staffed Daisy Days and finished cleanup work on Monday. On Wednesday, they prepped for Dancin' in the Street, but unfortunately the rain prevented the event from occurring. Thursday was spent drying out the tables, chairs and tents.
4. A training session was held related to traffic flagging through construction work zones. Public Works employees are required to be certified every three years.
5. Tree removal began on some of the Downtown trees that are in the sidewalk area. We will be grinding the stumps, replacing the soil mix, and replanting with new trees.

RE. Department Report

1. **Downtown Revitalization Project.** Notices to Bid on the first phase of the Train Station Improvement project was published Friday, May 17, 2019. A copy of the notice is posted at www.clarendonhills.us/bids. Bids will be accepted and opened on June 24, 2019. The project is expected to start in late July.

The Village received notice that the hearing before the Illinois Commerce Commission will be held on June 9, 2019 regarding the share costs associated for the Prospect Avenue gate improvements. This process is expected to take at least 6 months to complete. Meanwhile, the Illinois Department of Transportation has approved the Village's request to break up the streetscape improvement component into two phases: 1) Prospect Avenue and Burlington Avenue improvements; and 2) Installation of the outbound commuter and bicycle shelter. Phase 1 is expected to begin in November 2019.

All components of the Downtown Revitalization Project are scheduled to be completed by the end of 2020.

2. **Zoning Ordinance Modernization Project.** The Zoning Board of Appeals will be conducting a public hearing to review the draft comprehensive zoning ordinance amendment on August 15, 2019. 3. **Permits.** So far in June the Village has issued seventeen (17) building permits, including four (4) new single-family home, having a total reported construction value of \$3,945,178.
