Subject: Weekly Report

1. **Budget Update/Schedule** – We were originally expecting to approve the CY 2020 Budget at the December 2nd Board Meeting. Due to a posting issue, the Public Hearing and final approval is now scheduled for the December 16th Meeting. Budget materials are available on the Village website at www.clarendonhills.us/budget and paper copies are available at the Village Hall and Library.
2. **Meeting with Residents Regarding Drainage Concerns** – On Monday, Community Development Director Ungerleider and I met with residents from Juliet Court to discuss localized drainage concerns. The Village confirmed that we would work with the developer of property on Chicago Avenue to reduce potential concerns, of course within the scope of what we able to do per applicable regulations.
3. **Chestnut Alley Bid Opening** – Bids were opened this week for this project. The results were good, and we expect to bring this to the Board for approval at the December 2nd meeting.
4. **DMMC Board Meeting** – Village President Austin and I attended this meeting on Wednesday morning. The DuPage Foundation, a group that provides philanthropist support for various DuPage groups, spoke about their work and regular DMMC business was conducted.
5. **DMMC Regulatory Committee Meeting** – Later, on Wednesday, I attended this meeting. Presentations were made by Verizon and AT&T representatives regarding 5G and other telecommunications equipment being proposed in the region. We are working with other communities in the area to respond to their requests as a group. Staff also met with ComEd representatives this week in part to discuss the 5G issue.
6. **Chamber of Commerce Meeting** – was held Wednesday morning too. Several staff members attended and discussed various projects. The Chamber is moving forward with various projects to support business development and marketing. They spoke about their upcoming Board elections and the upcoming Christmas Walk in addition to their special Carriage rides being offered on December 21st. The Village continues to support these efforts.
7. **S & P Rating Call** – Another Wednesday happening. Finance Director Potempa and I participated in a “rating call” with S & P. The purpose is to confirm the Village’s bond rating for the upcoming issue. We believe that the call went well and expect the results in about two weeks.
8. **Metro Managers Meeting** – I attended this meeting on Thursday afternoon. The presentation that I helped organize, was on the growing concerns of ransomware.
9. **Thanksgiving Holiday Week – Village offices are closed** next week on Thursday and Friday for the holiday. Given this, we do not expect to have a weekly report. We also expect to have the packet for the December 2nd meeting distributed as early as Tuesday. We wish everyone a happy holiday.
10. **Holiday Decorations** – The Village Hall put up their indoor Christmas tree in preparation for the upcoming Christmas Walk to be held on December 6th at 6 PM.

1. Holiday decorating was the main focus this week. Light poles were wrapped with garland and wreaths were put up. Holiday banners and additional lighting will continue next week.
2. A gravel path was installed to access the temporary cell tower. The builder of the mixed-use building on this property has notified us that he will begin survey work next week and then dig for foundation footings.
3. A damaged pedestrian solar sign on Prospect was damaged by a motorists. Staff was able to repair and replace this the following day.
4. PW staff responded to a report of heat being out at the train station. It appears NICOR removed the service line prematurely. The contractor for the new train station will install temporary electric heat. The station is slated for demolition in mid-December. A temporary station will be erected prior to demolition.
5. NICOR began work for the installation of a new gas main along Eastern south of Harris. It will continue and tie in near Starbucks and an additional new line will be placed under the western sidewalk on the 100 block of Prospect.
6. NICOR is also working to install a new line in the Chestnut alley to serve the businesses on Burlington east of Golf.
7. Bids were opened for the Chestnut Alley Drainage Project. ALamp Concrete Contractors were the low bidder. This item is slated for approval at the December 2nd Village Board Meeting.

1. Fire Prevention Bureau Activity during the past week.
 - Eleven (11) Fire/Life Safety Inspections were conducted. All inspections for 2019 have been completed.
