1. The 2018 Road Improvement program trundles along. Concrete shoulder is in place on both sides of Tuttle and Arthur. Work on the apron replacements continues and preparation work on Oxford and Woodstock is underway. Shoulder work will begin on those streets next Wednesday.
2. Also trundling along is our parkway repair work. Now that we are fully staffed, we have made a dent in the backlog. We still have a few dozen tree stumps to fill.
3. We are nearly caught-up with our mowing work and should be on our regular schedule next week. Watering of flowers and turf is continuously underway.
4. The first ½ of the concrete driveway replacement at the Fire Station is complete. The second ½ is tentatively scheduled for next Monday.
5. A preconstruction conference for the Prospect Avenue Resurfacing project will be held during the week of July 23rd.

Recent events and training:

- Officers finished up with use of force decision making training.
- Sgt. Shirley attended a FIAT SWAT training session.
- Over the 4th of July holiday, officers participated in the IDOT seatbelt, distracted driving and DUI enforcement campaign. Officers wrote 33 citations during the campaign and made one traffic arrest.
- The Department received one of the new squads, which was ordered several months ago, and is currently being up-fitted.

Significant traffic and criminal activity during the period July 6, 2018 through July 12, 2018.

On July 6, 8:56am, officers stopped a Des Plaines resident on Ogden Ave. for a distracted driving violation. The driver did not have a valid driver's license. The subject was taken into custody and his car was impounded. He was released on bond.

On July 7, 11:00pm, officers discovered the Bee sculpture on the corner of Burlington and Prospect was knocked over and the base fasteners damaged. Pending.

On July 7, 4:50pm, officers stopped a Hinsdale resident for failure to wear a seatbelt. During the stop, officers discovered the driver was in possession of cannabis and drug paraphernalia. The driver was released after being cited for the seatbelt and drug paraphernalia violations.

On July 10, 1:30pm, officers responded to the 400 block of Traube for a hit and run complaint. The victim's car was struck while parked on the street.

On July 11, 9:59am, a USPS mail carrier reported that she was bitten by a dog while on her route. Officers contacted the dog's owner to verify proper vaccinations. The bite was reported to DuPage Animal Control for follow-up.
