

RESOLUTION NO. R-18-31
A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2018 DUPAGE COUNTY
NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the Village of Clarendon Hills is subject to natural hazards, such as, floods, severe summer and winter storms tornadoes, extreme heat events, and

WHEREAS, natural hazards can damage property, close businesses, disrupt traffic, can threaten lives, and present public health and safety hazards; and

WHEREAS, the DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Workgroup has prepared a and update the *DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan* that reviews the County's and the Village's options to protect people and reduce damage from the hazards; and

WHEREAS, the City/Village has participated in the development of the *2018 DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan*; and

WHEREAS, the recommended *2018 DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan* has been presented for review by residents, federal, state and regional agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Clarendon Hills, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the President and Board of Trustees hereby adopt the *2018 DuPage County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan* (the "Plan"), a copy of which is on file with the Village Clerk as an official plan of the Village.

SECTION 2: That the Plan identifies a series of action items. The following action items are hereby assigned to DuPage County or a department of the Village. The designated person or County department shall be responsible for the implementation of the action item, provided that resources are available, by the deadline listed in the Plan.

- a. Establish Sub-Workgroups within the Mitigation Workgroup (Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management)
- b. Enhance Public Participation in Mitigation Workgroup (Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management)

- c. National Weather Service Storm Ready Participation (Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management)
- d. Critical Infrastructure Identification and Verification (Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management)
- e. Critical Facility Back-Up Generation Assessment (Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management)
- f. Adopt County-Wide Public Outreach Monthly Topics (Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management)
- g. Flood Control and Property Protection Projects (Stormwater Management Department)
- h. Incorporate Mitigation Concepts into Future Planning (Stormwater Management Department)
- i. Participate in Tree City USA (Building & Zoning Department)
- j. Participate in Community Rating System (CRS) Program (Building & Zoning Department)
- k. Participate and Support Floodplain Management Studies (Stormwater Management Department)




