2019 Road Improvement Program

The project is to begin around June 17th and be completed by September 27, 2019. The project calls for a grind and overlay of the asphalt roads, the installation of a new concrete ribbon on the roads, partial or total replacement driveway aprons for most homes and drainage improvements.

The streets impacted by the work are as follows:

- The intersection of Holmes Avenue, Harris Avenue, and Eastern Avenue
- Walker Avenue from Park Avenue south to 55th Street.
- Prospect Avenue from Park Avenue south to 55th Street.
- Harris Avenue from Walker Avenue east to Prospect Avenue.
- Ann Street from Eastern Avenue to Harris Avenue
- Byrd Court from Ann Street to the Park District Pool parking lot.

The workday for the Road Improvement Program will begin at 7:00am and will end by 5:00pm, Monday-Friday.

Road closures will be in place during construction along the streets we are working on each work day from 7:00am to 5:00pm. A permanent detour route will be in effect 7 days a week after we complete the work in the five-way intersection. This will detour southbound traffic from Park Avenue east to Eastern Avenue then south on Holmes Avenue to 55th Street. The same detour route will be in effect for drivers going north into Downtown.

Temporary Road Closed signs will be set up at each end of our construction zones to detour through traffic around the active construction zone. If you live on a street under construction, you will have your driveway closed for a period of 10-14 days to allow the new concrete shoulder construction and driveway apron repairs to be completed.

During that active construction period you will be allowed to park along the street opposite your home overnight and on weekends. The same will occur to your neighbors who live across the street for 10-14 days also. **Residents with special needs may contact the Village and certain allowances will be made for them, but it will not include access to your driveway.**

Residents that have a driveway apron made of special materials (pavers, bricks etc.) will be contacted by the Village regarding keeping or disposing of the material. The Village will repair Irrigation systems damaged during this process towards the end of the project.

Your cooperation during construction is greatly appreciated. Overnight Parking Restrictions will be lifted during construction by the Police to allow residents to park near their homes overnight. Typical construction work hours will be 7:00am to 5:00pm on Monday through Friday. We will notify the trash company of our active construction zones and we will coordinate with them to get your trash picked up on Tuesdays. We need dry weather conditions for our schedule to be met. Rainy days will likely push the schedule back.
