

## **Seasonal Maintenance Worker**

The Village of Clarendon Hills, IL (pop. 8,540) is accepting applications to fill one Seasonal Maintenance Worker for this summer. Clarendon Hills is located in DuPage County approximately 17 miles west of Downtown Chicago and is between the Villages of Westmont and Hinsdale.

The Seasonal Maintenance Worker duties include, but are not limited to, operating manual and powered equipment include weed eaters, brush chippers and related equipment; maintaining and repairing exteriors and interiors of public buildings and facilities; painting, changing street lights; assisting in maintenance and installation of ditches, culverts and manholes.

Requires an ability to understand and follow instructions, communicate effectively, operate equipment safely and the ability to perform strenuous work in varying weather conditions.

Applicants must possess a valid Illinois Driver's License, and be able to lift and/or move up to 50 pounds on a frequent basis, 100+ pounds occasionally. Must also be able to successfully pass a pre-employment medical exam, including a drug screen, and a criminal background check.

Pay for the position is \$10.00/hour.

Employment schedule is a 40 hour work week, typically between 7:00 AM - 3:30 PM, Monday-Friday (except on concert days\*).

\*The position requires availability on Wednesday nights to assist in the set-up and tear-down of the summer concert series, Dancin' in the Street. Concerts are on June 19, June 26, July 10, July 17, July 24, July 31 and a rainout date, if needed is scheduled for August 7. The typical concert day shift will begin at 3:30 at 3:30 PM and tear-down completing by 11:30 PM.
