

Subject: Village of Clarendon Hills
2024 Road Program

August 2nd 2024

Dear Resident:

The Village of Clarendon Hills will be resurfacing:

- Holmes Avenue from 58th St. to 55th St
- 56th St. from Barclay Ct. to Forest Hill Drive
- 58th St. from Holmes Ave to the East End

The project is funded by Rebuild Illinois Bond Funds, Motor Fuel Tax Funds, and Local Funds and is anticipated to last until the end of August.

Work is scheduled to begin the week of August 5th and anticipated to commence as follows:

1. Erection of Traffic Control and Protection (Today)
2. Sidewalk, Curb, and Driveway replacement to correct drainage or structural deficiencies.
 - Driveway replacement will only occur as necessary to restore damage behind locations where curb or sidewalk is replaced. Access to apartment complexes will be handled by completing driveways half at a time or by using other driveway access points. When barricades are blocking access, the concrete may be wet, curing, or present a hazard.
3. Temporary removal of existing roadway frames and roadway surface course Removal
4. Roadway patching as necessary and Hot-Mix Asphalt Leveling Binder installation (1st lift).
5. Reinstallation of roadway frames temporarily removed in item (3.) to final grade.
6. Final Hot-Mix Asphalt Surface installation
7. Striping, Landscaping, and Project Punchlist.

Please refrain from parking on Holmes Avenue, 56th or 58th during working hours. **No Parking Signs will be posted as required throughout construction. Work will begin promptly at 7:00 am and end as late as 6:00pm**, Monday through Friday. If permitted, Saturday work may occur and will begin at 8:00 am. We anticipate that all work will be completed using lane closures with flaggers, so access will be interrupted intermittently. Trash will still be picked up as scheduled. You may put out your trash receptacles the evening before pickup.

Overnight Parking on Holmes will be permitted if you do not have access to your parking area. No calls to the Police Department are needed. They are aware of the project.
