Dear Resident:

The Village of Clarendon Hills will be improving driveways and alleys and parking lots at the following locations:

- 229 Middaugh
- Village Hall Parking Lot
- 231 Burlington Avenue
- 4 McIntosh Avenue (Alley)

The project is funded by Rebuild Illinois Bond Funds, Motor Fuel Tax Funds, and Local Funds and is anticipated to last until the end of August.

Work is scheduled to begin the week of August 5th and anticipated to commence as follows:

1. Removal of existing Asphalt.
2. Sidewalk or Curb replacement to achieve ADA compliance, correct drainage, or correct structural deficiencies.
3. Base preparation and repair as required by condition.
4. Hot-Mix asphalt installation
5. Striping, Landscaping, and Project Punchlist as required.

Please refrain from using the driveway during working hours. **No Parking Signs will be posted as required throughout construction. Work will begin promptly at 7:00 am and end as late as 6:00pm**, Monday through Friday. If permitted, Saturday work may occur and will begin at 8:00 am. Trash will still be picked up as scheduled. You may put out your trash receptacles the evening before pickup.

Overnight Parking in front of each residence/business will be permitted if you cannot remove your vehicle prior to 7:00am. No calls to the Police Department are needed. They are aware of the project.
